
FY17 Tithe

Habitat affiliates in the United States send at least 10% of their undesignated funds to developing countries where Habitat builds around the world. This money, or tithe, supports opportunities for hundreds of families in countries such as Haiti and the Philippines, in addition to the families served locally. In FY17, Minnesota affiliates and Habitat Minnesota tithed over \$420,000, bringing strength, stability, and independence to families all over the world.

National Stats

In FY17 **\$14,011,000** tithed

 3,100 total families served through US tithe



- \$2,609 median tithe
- \$11,703 average tithe



Over \$258 million has been tithed by US affiliates to date, serving more than 81.100 families!



\$422,830 tithed in FY17

84 families served

To date, **\$8,604,786** has been tithed by Minnesota, serving more than 2,510 families!

Thanks to US tithe, hundreds of people all over the world have become homeowners! Countries supported include Colombia, Ethiopia, Ghana, Guatemala, Nicaragua, and the Philippines, to name a few. In addition, many affiliates supported Habitat International priority funds such as the Global Mission Fund, Orphans and Vulnerable Groups Fund, and Disaster Response Fund, meant to send tithe to countries and groups that need it most each year.

Meager Meal (at the 2018 OLE Conference)

Sponsored Country: Haiti was identified in 2017 as a high-priority organization for tithe based on their low income and great housing need.

Impact: Free will donations collected at the Meager Meal totaled over \$600! Meal sponsorship allowed an additional \$2,000 to be donated to Haiti as well.

Tithe Recognitions

Habitat Minnesota received a Malachi 3:10 award, recognizing a lifetime tithe of over \$500,000!

Twin Cities Habitat received the John 3:16 award, recognizing a lifetime tithe of over \$3 million!
