Partnerships – September 2017

As supporting organizations, Habitat for Humanity of Minnesota and Habitat for Humanity-International provide resources for Habitat affiliates in many ways, such as partnering with organizations, both national and local, for the benefit of affiliates. Partnerships help to provide home building materials, appliances, and grants.

Minnesota Partnerships

Uponor, a manufacturer of water distribution systems with US Headquarters here in Minnesota, partnered with Habitat in 2017 to donate rough-in plumbing systems to 20 homes across the state. The value of material donated so far is over \$26,000! In addition, you can find Uponor employees volunteering at Habitat job sites around Minnesota.

Western National Insurance awarded Habitat Minnesota over \$10,000 to offset the cost of providing training in building to the **FORTIFIED Home™** disaster-resistant standards. In addition, Habitat Minnesota is using these funds to provide cash grants for local Habitat offices at several stages of the FORTIFIED construction process.

Re-Introducing **MINNCOR**: Transforming lives for community success and safety. The Northfield MINNCOR production facility provides work skills to offenders in a financially self-sufficient model. For at least ten years, Habitat affiliates across the state have partnered with MINNCOR for cabinetry; the product is excellent and the price point competitive.
