## Useful Facts and Figures— Data for Affiliates

Resources Distributed – February 2018

### Over \$2.4 million was distributed by Habitat Minnesota in FY17

Habitat for Humanity of Minnesota is a statewide resource development and support organization that serves, advocates for and advances the work of Minnesota’s Habitat for Humanity affiliates. To truly support and develop resources for our affiliates, Habitat Minnesota expanded from solely providing loan and grant funds to include new and developing resources needed by affiliates. With each year, Habitat Minnesota adapts to better serve affiliates so they can, in turn, partner with more families across the state and world.

Habitat Minnesota has distributed over **\$87.6 million** since its creation in 1997.  
**\$2,422,722** was distributed in Fiscal Year 17.

**19** Minnesota affiliates participated in the Ride and received a total of **\$180,990!**  
**\$319,377** was distributed to Habitat affiliates across the state, country, and world.  
**40 volunteers** supported the event.

#### Loan and Grant Department

**Habitat MN Loan Fund:** \$1,481,145 was distributed to 9 affiliates.  
**Impact Fund:** \$411,000 was distributed to 17 affiliates.  
**FHLB New Assistance:** \$211,200 was distributed to 12 affiliates.

#### New Partnership

In February 2017, **Uponor** partnered with Habitat Minnesota to provide plumbing equipment (**valued at \$30,000**) for affiliates. Uponor agreed to donate one full plumbing rough-in material kit to affiliates, up to a total of 20 systems.

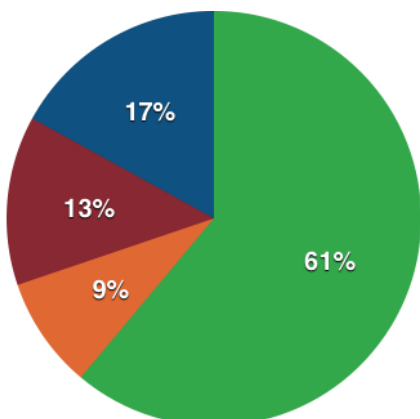
#### Affiliate Visits

Habitat Minnesota staff made more than **130 visits** to 28 Minnesota affiliates in FY17.

#### Sustainable Building Program

The SBP partnered with **28 Minnesota affiliates** in FY17.  
**17** Greater Minnesota affiliates built **28 homes** to Green Communities standards.
